- Coordinate the pool usage of all students.
- Develop and implement a budget. Also responsible for purchasing related to all aquatic programs and services.
- Take responsibility for writing policies and procedures that relate to the pool and the swimming program (emergency procedures and drills, safety related policies)
- Assist the Administration in determining and communicating the goals of the Aquatics program and how they align with the Mission, Vision and Values of AISB.
- Effectively apply technology to facilitate office functions and job responsibilities.
- Effectively use online grading programs and course management tool
