Please join us in the Multipurpose Room for an orientation to the Elementary School Division of AISB. We will present important information and offer you a tour of the building. Transportation and school lunch representatives will be available to you as well. We look forward to meeting you and answering your questions before the first days of school.

First Days of School (Grades PreK3, PreK4 & Kind)

The first two days of school for students in Pre-Kindergarten 3/4 and Kindergarten are "introduction days." Your child's teacher will contact you in August and set up a time for you to come to school with your child for an introductory visit. During this time you will have the opportunity to learn about the program, ask questions, and your child will have an opportunity to learn about his/her classroom. Pre-Kindergarten 3/4 and Kindergarten students begin school on the **regular full-day schedule (8:30-3:30) on Wednesday, August 25th**.

English as a Second Language (EAL) tests (Grades 1-5)

Every possibly EAL student will be tested on **Thursday, August 19, 2010 from 9:00 to 10:00 a.m.** Every family will be contacted with an individual appointment.

First Day of School (Grades 1-5)

When: Monday, August 23, 2010
Times: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Students may come to school by bus (please make prior arrangements with Sargent Bus Service in August) or parents may bring their children to school. If you choose to bring your child to school we request that you drop him or her at the lobby or classroom door, and not visit with the teacher at that time. We would like teachers to be able to give their full attention to their students during those first hours of school. Time will be available in the afternoon for you to talk to the teacher if you wish.

Bus transportation, PSA and school lunch program tables will be available from 8:30 a.m.
